Pupils tried 'primordial soup' which is based on miso soup. They also made fish out of recycled plastic bottles.

The lower school were looking at connections in electric circuits. They had great fun with the buzzers.

There was a STEM challenge to make a balloon rocket where pupils had to research the best methods, test out different things and work as a team.
